

EA MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

We provide this list so that some of the general school supplies can be purchased over the summer for the upcoming school year. Different teachers have different expectations for each class, and so it will be necessary to purchase some items as we begin in September. The items would reflect the specific needs outlined in expectations that come from each teacher. For notebooks, it is best to go with one-inch, three-ring binders as the larger ones are very clumsy to carry. In addition, some teachers expect students to have a single binder for class. If you purchase spiral notebooks for paper, please go with the ones that have a thin line of perforations, which make it easier to tear out the page. A generic list of items below:

- EA Student Planner - provided to every student on the 1st day of school (*Each teacher uses this as the “go to” agenda for keeping track of assignments and homework on a day- to-day basis*).
- #2 pencils or mechanical pencils with soft lead.
- Blue or black ballpoint pens.
- Highlighter. Any color is fine, although some prefer the standard yellow.
- Colored pencils or markers.
- One-inch, three-ring binders (*Please do NOT purchase a bunch of large binders - they will be too big to carry around. Please note that several binders may be required depending on the requirements for each course*).
- Loose-leaf paper for 3-ring binders.
- Subject dividers for 3-ring binders.
- Spiral notebook (*Please note that several notebooks may be required depending on the requirements for each course*).
- A bound composition notebook with college-ruled lines (*6th-grade, Spanish students only*).
- Index cards (*preferably 3 x 5*).
- Graph Paper Bound Composition Book & Loose graph paper.
- TI 30 range Calculator (for 7th and 8th-grade math students).
- College Ruled Composition book.
- Earbuds/Headphones for laptops.

NOTE: It is recommended that all binders, notebooks, folders, and textbooks purchased should have the student’s name, subject (*where applicable*) and homeroom teacher clearly printed on the outside cover.

COURSE LOAD

Sixth Grade: Math, Science, English, History and World Language along with elective courses in Religion, Art, Perspectives, Theater, Introduction to Computer Science & Engineering, Tech 2.0, Study & Research Skills, and Music.

I & II Form: Math, Science, English, History, World Language and Latin along with Religion, Art, Health and any elected trimester courses.
