



dress code

GENERAL NOTES

- Sweatshirts and sweatpants, fleece tops, jackets, or boots may be worn only as outerwear, and are taken off upon arrival to class.
- Belts are preferred if pants have belt loops (except PK & K).
- Polo shirts and turtlenecks must be tucked in at all times
- The EA logo is the only logo permitted on any part of the uniform.
- Nail polish and makeup are not recommended.
- Jewelry, other than simple earrings, should not be worn.
- Girls' hair accessories should be small.
- While EA does not dictate hair length, please help your child to maintain clean, brushed, and combed hair.

SHOES

- Shoes may be any color or pattern and should be sturdy, neat, and in good repair. Athletic shoes (i.e. sneakers) are permitted. All footwear must enclose the entire foot and cover toes. Laces must be tied. No sandals, clogs, or backless shoes, shoes with wheels, high heels, slippers, or open-toe shoes.
- Girls may wear solid plain navy tights or ankle-length leggings (no lace edging).
- Boots are encouraged in winter weather. Students change out of boots and into athletic shoes upon entering the classroom, and then change back into boots for recess and dismissal.

SPECIAL DRESS DAYS

Special dress is required for Convocation, Thanksgiving and Christmas Chapels, concerts, Closing Exercises, and other special events.

- Khaki/blue pants, jumper (PreK-3) or skort (4-5)
- White polo with EA Stripes sweater
- If worn, headbands should be conservative styles in blue or white
- On certain special Chapel days and concerts, we'll ask that students wear leggings with the skort or jumper. Students should also wear brown or black shoes.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Girls should wear shorts under their jumper for PE class (it is easier for them to wear them all day so that they can be active on the playground).
